<u>Curbside Compost Pickup</u> – will resume on May 4<sup>th</sup> (May the fourth be with you). We will pick up your compost every Thursday from May until the first week of November. Again this year, compost must be in a clear bag. **Bag tags are** available at the Town Office free of charge, as we require your address on each bag. Animal feces and garbage cannot be in this bag, or it will be left behind.

RCMP Retroactive Pay – In 2021 the Government of Canada and the National Police Federation negotiated a collective agreement for RCMP officers that includes substantial retroactive pay increases dating back to April 1, 2017. Since the contract was announced SUMA, the Federation of Canadian Municipalities (FCM), and other municipal groups have advocated to the Government of Canada to absorb the retroactive costs associated with the contract. Unfortunately the recently released federal budget did not include a federal commitment to absorb the costs of the RCMP retroactive pay decision. At this time we still do no know the financial impact to municipalities in Saskatchewan.
